- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 bottle of glass cleaner
- 1 can of scouring powder
- 1 toilet bowl brush
- 3 scrubber sponges
- 3 new kitchen towels
- 2 new hot pads
- 1 bottle of dish detergent
- 1 bottle of laundry detergent
- 1 large laundry basket or plastic storage bin
- 1 can opener
- 1 box of plastic wrap
- 1 box of 5-oz. paper cups
- 1 dish pan and drainer
- 1 box of kitchen garbage bags

### Miscellaneous

- 1 new blanket/quilt for a full-size bed

- 3 razors
- 1 stick of deodorant
- 1 12-oz. bottle of moisturizing lotion
