- 1 can of scouring powder
- 1 toilet bowl brush
- 2 scrubber sponges
- 2 new kitchen towels
- 2 new hot pads
- 1 bottle of dish detergent
- 1 bottle of laundry detergent
- 1 large laundry basket or plastic storage bin
- 1 can opener
- 1 box of plastic wrap
- 1 dish pan and drainer
- 1 box of kitchen garbage bags

Miscellaneous

- 1 new full sized blanket or quilt
- pots and pans, cooking utensils
- dishes, flatware
- storage containers
- gift cards to local stores



Bathroom

- 2 new bath towels
- 2 new hand towels
- 2 new washcloths
- 1 new bathmat
- 1 shower curtain and rings
- 3 rolls of toilet paper
